

House Rules

These house rules are valid for all persons present in Haus Mödrath, regardless of purpose. By entering the premises of Haus Mödrath, visitors accept our rules as well as all other regulations concerning the maintaining of operational safety. Haus Mödrath is a private house, which is open to visitors at limited times.

Admission and Cloakroom

- Admission fees can be found at the ticket desk or online at “www.haus-moedrath.de”.
- Admission tickets take the form of paper armbands that must always be worn around the wrist.
- Children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- All coats, jackets, umbrellas, walking sticks, backpacks and bags or other receptacles larger than DinA4 must be left in the cloakroom, without exception. No liability will be assumed for the loss or damage of items left in the cloakroom.

Behavior in the exhibition spaces

- Under no circumstances may an exhibition piece be touched. Visitors must maintain a distance of at least 50 cm to each artwork.
- In the case that an artwork is damaged, the security staff is entitled to take the name and address of the perpetrator.
- Visitors are liable for any damage caused by them.
- Parents and guardians as well as group supervisors are responsible for maintaining order among children and adolescents they are accompanying.
- Food and drink are not permitted in the exhibition spaces.
- Smoking is not permitted anywhere in the house. Smoking is only permitted outdoors on the premises where ashtrays have been set up.
- Chairs may not be moved from their specified positions.
- Repeated violations of these house rules or refusals to accept the instructions of the staff can lead to being banned from a further visit to Haus Mödrath.
- The instructions of the security staff must be followed.

Filming and photographing, mobile telephones and audio devices

- Photography and filming are not permitted in the exhibition spaces, likewise telephoning or operating audio devices.
- If a photographer documents special events photographically – e.g. for our archive or for publication in e.g. social media – and you do not want this, please let the present photographer know that.

General Information

- For security reasons, the exhibition spaces are under video surveillance.
- Animals are not permitted on the grounds of Haus Mödrath.
- In the case of a rush of visitors or for other special reasons, Haus Mödrath can be closed to visitors completely or in part.
- For security reasons, staircases, passageways and emergency exits must not be blocked.
- In the case of a burglar alarm, the administration of Haus Mödrath is entitled to lock all exits and conduct a security check.
- Haus Mödrath is only open to the public during its official opening hours.
